Students in the Tennessee counties of: Hancock, Hawkins, Sullivan and Washington are eligible for the TTAG grant as well as the cities of Bristol, Kingsport and Johnson City.





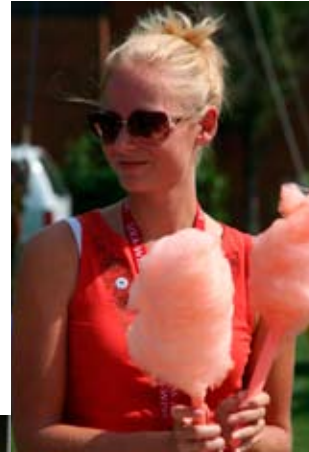
Serving Our Neighbors

UVa-Wise was founded with the mission of educating students from far southwestern Virginia. Since 1954, thousands of students from the Commonwealth, and a number of other states, have received the prestigious University of Virginia diploma. To make Uva-Wise more affordable to out of state students, the College offers a reduction in tuition for several of our neighboring counties in Kentucky and Tennessee. The tuition assistance grants allow students to look to UVa-Wise, a small, liberal arts college for a quality, affordable education. The Virginia General Assembly allowed us to offer reduced tuition to our neighbors in Kentucky in 1996. It has proven successful in allowing more students from Kentucky to attend. A similar agreement was reached in July 2004 to assist students in four counties in northeast Tennessee.

Helping Ourselves

Studies show that students who attend a college less than four hours from home are more satisfied and graduate. The KTAG & TTAG grants make the College more affordable to students who are less than two hours away.

With a goal to serve 2,000, highly qualified students by 2010, the TAG program makes the College a more feasible choice. With generous financial aid packages that students receive, UVa-Wise becomes an affordable opportunity.



By Helping Others

UVa-Wise currently has 1,950 students studying on our 400 acre campus. The attention students receive here is comparable to that received at small private colleges, without the private college price.

UVa-Wise is the only branch college of the University of Virginia. With the help of the University we are able to offer services not usually found at schools of our size.
